4. How many eye surgeons are on call during the Holiday Season in December-January? (Request covers last three years 2015/16, 2016/17 and 2017/18)

Response:

The West Coast DHB does not have any resident eye surgeons (ophthalmologists) operating on the West Coast. All elective ophthalmology surgery is contracted out to private providers. Any patients who present acutely who might need immediate ophthalmic treatment during the holiday season in December – January in any year are referred directly to the ophthalmology services of Canterbury District Health Board for acute care.
