I note your request was clarified on 3 February 2019 as being for Notifiable diseases and Mental Health and over the last ten years.

Copies of any reports, documents, memoranda, correspondence, legal advice or emails, both internal
and external regarding concerns for the health of Gloriavale residents on the West Coast of the South
Island.

The only emails we hold relating to Mental Health in Gloriavale relate to specific individuals, we are declining to provide these under section 9(2)(a) of the Official Information Act i.e. "....to protect the privacy of natural persons, including those deceased". We are not aware of any other reports on mental health concerns in Gloriavale.

Notes:

- 1. Infection with VTEC/STEC = Verotoxin/Shiga toxin producing *E.coli*.
- 2. There were relatively high numbers of notifications of enteric diseases (gastroenteritis illnesses) in 2008 and these have fallen subsequently. This is in part due to improvements in the safety of the Gloriavale Community's water supply. Enteric diseases still remain the most common type of notifiable disease in this community, as is the case for rural areas and the West Coast generally.
- 3. There were no notifications of notifiable diseases from Gloriavale in 2009.

The West Coast DHB declines to provide any detail on the individual cases pursuant to section 9 (2)(a) of the Official information Act 1982 i.e. "....to protect the privacy of natural persons, including those deceased". This includes any emails to/from notifying practitioners in respect of individual cases.
