## **RE Official Information Act request WCDHB 9396**

I refer to your email dated 20 February 2020 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from West Coast DHB specifically:

 The number of births per month at Kawatiri Maternity Unit in the past five years (to June 30, 2019), and the number of Buller mothers who birthed in Greymouth Hospital over the same period (also per month please).

The number of births at Kawatiri Maternity Unit and for Buller-domiciled mothers who gave birth at Grey Base Hospital (based on date of discharge from hospital), by month over the last five years to 30 June 2019 are as follows:

## 2. The number of home births in Buller per month over the same period.

Self-employed Lead Maternity Carers report birth activity directly to the Minsitry of Health, who then collate and report data back to DHBs for their regions by calendar year only. Accordingly, home births for the Buller region reported to West Coast DHB over the last five calendar years have been as follows:

## 3. The number of Buller mothers who birthed outside the Coast over the same period.

Self-employed Lead Maternity Carers report birth activity directly to the Minsitry of Health, who then collate and report data back to DHBs for their regions by calendar year only. Data collated by the Ministry of Health for the number of Buller mothers birthing off the West Coast for 2018 and 2019 has not yet been released to DHBs. For the prior calendar years, the number of such cases reported had been as follows:

- 2015 49
- 2016 54
- 2017 40
- 4. The number of patient transfers from Buller Hospital to hospitals elsewhere, per month, in the past five years (to June 30, 2019).
- The number of those transfers to each hospital (ie Greymouth, Christchurch, Nelson).
- 6. The number of transfers from Buller Hospital by ambulance, and the number by helicopter, per month, for the same period.
- 7. The cost of ambulance transfers from Buller each year, and the cost of helicopter transfers each year.
- 8. The number of fixed wing transfers per month from Buller over the five years, and the cost of those transfers.
- 9. The number of those fixed wing transfers to each hospital.

Response to Questions 4 to 9:

Please see the tables attached as **Appendix 1** that provide the month by month breakdown of patients transferred from our Buller Health facility to hospitals in other centres by the various modes of road and air transfer as you have requested in questions 4 to 9 above, for the five years from 1 July 2014 to 30 June 2019.

With regard to transfer costs, the current cost in 2019/20 to West Coast DHB for an ambulance transfer from Buller to Grey Hospital is \$460 per trip. The cost of helicopter and fixed wing aircraft transfers vary dependent on destination and flight time, so each flight can be unique. On average, the current cost of a helicopter air ambulance flight from Buller to Grey in 2019/20 is usually around \$5,455 per return trip. Helicopter transfers from Buller to Christchurch may range from \$15,750 to just under \$17,000 for a return trip, and those to Nelson from \$12,000 to just over \$15,000. Fixed wing aircraft costs vary considerably due to flight time, destination, and crew configuration.

ACC pays for inter-hospital transfers that occur within 24 hours of accident for those patients who have an accident-related event. West Coast DHB otherwise pays the cost for those inter-hospital transfers made at request of DHB staff.

We are unable to provide overall costs in respect of specific modes of transport type used for interhospital transfers. Transfers of all type are coded to one account within the West Coast DHB, and there is no specific breakdown of information by transport mode, nor separating out for the Buller region, for the time periods you have requested. To endeavour to extract the figures for helicopter transfers (or other specific transport modes) would require a manual review, sorting and compilation of data from archived invoices relating to each individual patient transfer. As such, the information requested cannot be made available without substantial additional cost, collation and research. Because of that, we decline your request to provide this information under Section 18(f) of the Official Information Act on the grounds of substantial collation and research.

I trust that this satisfies your interest in this matter.
