RE Official information request WCDHB 9470

I refer to your email received 8 September 2020 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from the West Coast DHB. Specifically:

For the period September 1 2019 to August 31 2020, a weekly breakdown of the following information:

- 1. Number of ED presentations.
- 2. Number of overall hospital capacity.
- 3. Number of the overall number of referrals received for first specialist assessments for planned care, and the number of FSA that took place. (subsequently clarified as relating to specialist medical and surgical services.)

In regard to Question 1 and 3: Please find the answers to the elements of these two questions attached as Appendices 1-3. These volumes are given as per the week commencing on the date listed for the number of weekly Emergency Department (ED) presentations, referrals received, and Specialist FSAs undertaken. The exception in each Appendix is the information given for 31 August; being the start of a week in the time series requested, this data is given just for that single day.

<u>In regard to Question 2:</u> During the period 1 September 2019 and up to the last week of July 2020, the overall hospital capacity for ED, medical and surgical services beds at Grey Base Hospital was 48; made up as follows:

- surgical beds 17
- medical beds 17
- critical care unit 4
- paediatrics 4
- emergency (not used for formal admissions) 6

The numbers listed above excludes inpatient maternity beds, acute mental health beds and the age residential care beds at the hospital, as well as chairs used in areas such as post-surgical recovery, infusion and chemotherapy services, and the like.

During the last week of July 2020, the main sections of the Grey Base Hospital incorporating medical, surgical, maternity, paediatric, ED and outpatient services were closed; with services being transferred

and moved across to a new facility on campus. This new building - Te Nikau Hospital and Health Centre – includes the following hospital bed capacities for ED, medical and surgical services:

- 32 beds in the General Ward
- 4 beds in Critical Care Unit
- 2 paediatric beds (noting that paediatrics can gain additional beds by utilising the acute medical assessment beds which are co-located adjacent to paediatrics, to allow capacity to increase in response to increased demand).
- 8 emergency department beds
- 4 acute medical observation beds.

This hospital capacity at Te Nikau likewise does not include the numbers of maternity inpatient beds or patient chairs used in day service treatment areas, such as the likes of the infusion and chemotherapy services; nor acute mental health beds and the age residential care beds that remain in service on the Grey hospital campus.

I trust this satisfies your interest in this matter.
