## **RE Official information request WCDHB 9513**

I refer to your email dated 6 January 2021 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from West Coast DHB. Specifically:

 The total number of body part items returned to patients by the DHB during the calendar years of 2020, 2019, and 2018, broken down by the specific type of body part (including but not limited to, body tissue, bones, organs, placentas/products of conception) returned each year.

West Coast DHB does not keep a central record of the number of various body parts and tissues (including but not limited to, body tissue, bones, organs, placentas/products of conception) that have been returned to patients. The only record of such information is held in the individual records and clinical notes of the patients concerned.

There are approximately 11,500 patients seen though our emergency department and 7,500 patients discharged from our inpatient services every year, and each individual's clinical notes for each year would need to be manually reviewed and researched to determine the information you have requested. We are therefore declining to provide a response to your request pursuant to Section 18(f) of the Official Information Act, i.e. "that the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research."
