RE Official Information Act request WCDHB 9544

I refer to your email dated 19 April 2021 this morning requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from West Coast DHB. Specifically:

- **1.** How many children aged 0-14 have presented to hospital with a dog-related injury in the last year?
- 2. How many of those children required a procedure (e.g. sutures), or admission?
- 3. What was the ethnicity and age demographics of those children?

There were seven children in the age group 0 - 14 years age group who presented at our Emergency Department services and were treated for dog-related injuries in the calendar year 1 January - 31 December 2020. None required admission to hospital.

By age and ethnicity demographic, the seven children concerned identified as follows:

- 2 children in the 0-5 year old age cohort (1 Maori and 1 NZ European);
- 3 children in the age 6-10 year old age cohort (1 Asian and 2 NZ European);
- 2 children in the 11-14 year old age cohort (both NZ European)

I trust this satisfies your interest in this matter.
