Noise

We know the work we are doing is at times noisy and we apologise for that. Contractors will be installing the composite floor decking and this process can be noisy as the sheets are moved across the steelwork and fixed down. A lot of the noise impact will depend on which way the wind is blowing.

Steel

The project is tracking along as planned and the erection of the structural steel has been a significant project milestone. The North Wing structural steel, roof steel and purlins are complete and the facade steel has commenced – it shows off the shape of the building nicely.

Parking

Over the next year there will be some phased changes to the car parking on site as staged works within the existing hospital grounds will result in parking closures on the campus. Please look out for signage indicating where patient and visitor car parking is located.
